Sample Scholarship Calculations

EXAMPLE #1

Family Size: 4
Annual Income: **\$18,500.00**

Line 6 is the *maximum award amount* (\$1,500 for PK-8, \$1800 for 9-12)

Line 7 is your *estimated annual scholarship*.

Line 8 is the *estimated amount you pay annually before fees*.

1. Amount of school tuition:	Line 1	\$3,500
2. Amount of financial aid NOT from CSF:	Line 2	\$0
3. Subtract line 2 from line 1:	Line 3	\$3,500
4. If you qualify for a 75% scholarship, write "0.75"; If you qualify for a 50% scholarship, write "0.5"; If you qualify for a 25% scholarship, write "0.25";	Line 4	0.75
5. Multiply line 3 by line 4:	Line 5	\$2,625
6. Write "\$X,XXX"	Line 6	\$X,XXX
7. Write the SMALLER amount of lines 5 & 6:	Line 7	\$X,XXX
8. Subtract line 7 from line 3:	Line 8	\$X,XXX

EXAMPLE #2

Family Size: 5
Annual Income: **\$50,000.00**

Line 6 is the *maximum award amount*.

Line 7 is your *estimated annual scholarship*.

Line 8 is the *estimated amount you pay annually before fees*.

1. Amount of school tuition:	Line 1	\$3,750
2. Amount of financial aid NOT from CSF:	Line 2	\$100
3. Subtract line 2 from line 1:	Line 3	\$3,650
4. If you qualify for a 75% scholarship, write "0.75"; If you qualify for a 50% scholarship, write "0.5"; If you qualify for a 25% scholarship, write "0.25";	Line 4	0.25
5. Multiply line 3 by line 4:	Line 5	\$912.50
6. Write "\$X,XXX"	Line 6	\$X,XXX
7. Write the SMALLER amount of lines 5 & 6:	Line 7	\$X,XXX
8. Subtract line 7 from line 3:	Line 8	\$X,XXX

Note: *The above examples are for illustration purposes only and are not intended to represent the amount of the scholarship you may receive. Please remember that each family must pay at least \$500 towards tuition.*
